Course Description

The American Board of Telehealth's CORE - Clinical, Operational, Regulatory and Ethics - Concepts in Telehealth Certificate Program provides a comprehensive program to envelope the learner in vital aspects of telehealth implementation and delivery across a broad spectrum of service areas. The CORE Concepts in Telehealth Certificate Program is launched in sequence with the publication of validated telehealth competency development with Harvard Medical School. The curriculum includes 7 on-line modules taking the learner through interactive, engaging content and case scenarios while still offering the flexibility of completing the course at the learner's pace and time.

- Recognize variability in requirements and procedures from each state licensing board and facility in regards to telehealth licensing, credentialing and privileging.
- 12. Interpret legal and professional regulatory standards for providing care at a distance.
- 13. Describe basic telehealth coverage and reimbursement.
- 14. Discuss state regulations regarding telehealth reimbursement policies.
- 15. Examine CMS, Medicare, Medicaid requirements for telehealth services.
- Identify ethical considerations of the patient and provider that should be addressed in the telehealth setting.
